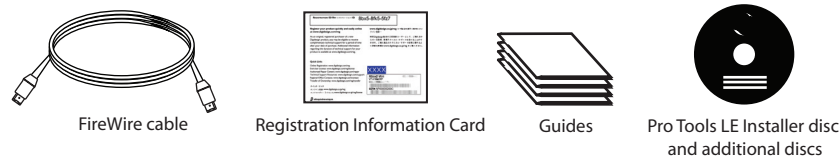


## 003 Family Quick Setup

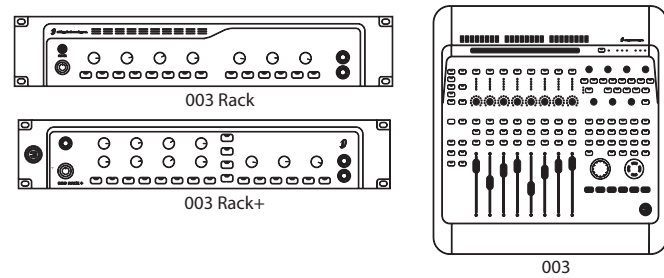
Follow these simple steps to get your Pro Tools® system installed and to start making music.

### 1. Basic Contents

Your 003® family interface and Pro Tools LE® package comes with:

**Tip:** We encourage you to read the 003 Family Setup Guide after completing these Quick Setup instructions. It contains detailed information about setting up and configuring software and hardware for optimum performance.

### 5. Get Installed on Your Mac

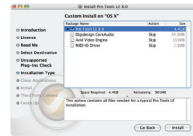
If you have a Mac, here's how to install your Pro Tools LE software:

- Locate and double-click the Pro Tools LE installer on the Installer disc. It looks like this:

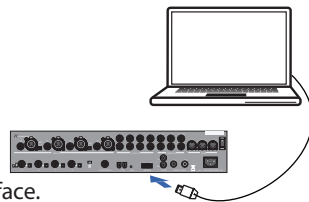


- Follow the on-screen instructions to proceed with installation.
- When prompted to select features to install, leave Pro Tools selected. You can also select optional items. (For more information see your printed *Setup Guide*.)

**Tip:** Click (highlight) the item's name to read its description.

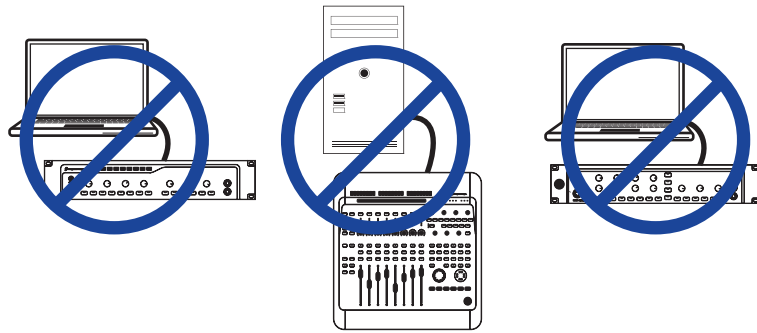


- Follow the remaining on-screen instructions until you are prompted to connect your interface.
- Connect the FireWire cable to your computer and the other end of the cable to your interface. Plug in your interface and power it up.
- When installation is complete, click **Restart**.
- Now you're ready to launch and authorize Pro Tools.

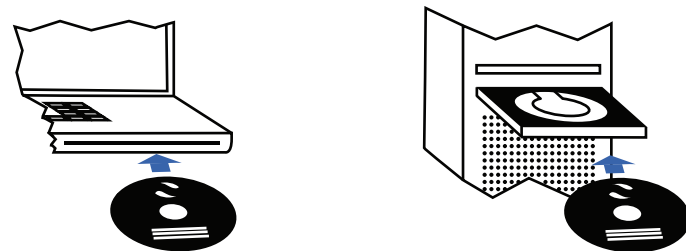


### 2. Software First, then Hardware

You may want to connect your interface right away, but wait!



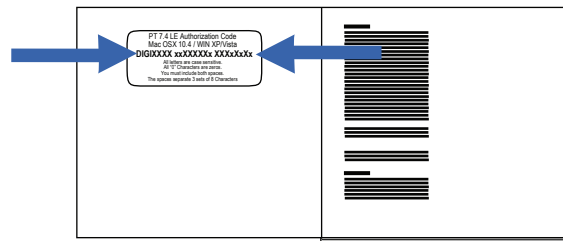
First, insert the Pro Tools LE Installer disc.



### 6. Launch and Authorize Pro Tools

When you launch Pro Tools LE software the first time, you'll be prompted to enter an Authorization Code. You must authorize Pro Tools before you can use it.

- Go to the inside front cover of the *Setup Guide* to locate your Authorization Code. (The code begins with the letters DIGI.)



**Tip:** All letters are case sensitive. All "0" characters are zeros. Include spaces. (The spaces separate 3 sets of 8 characters.)

- Enter your code and click **Validate**.
- Pro Tools installation is complete. Now you can choose whether you want to create a new session or use a session template.

### 3. Get Installed with Windows

If you have Windows, here's how to install your Pro Tools LE software:

- Locate and double-click the Pro Tools LE Setup icon.

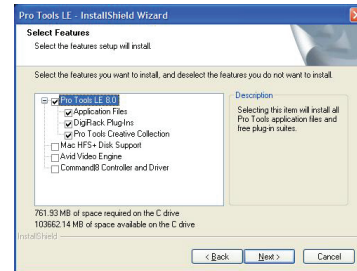
It looks like this:



[ In Vista, if the User Account Control dialog appears, just click **Allow**. ]

- Follow the on-screen instructions to proceed with installation.
- When prompted to select features to install, leave Pro Tools selected. You can also select optional items. (For more information, see your printed *Setup Guide*.)

**Tip:** Click (highlight) the item's name to read its description.

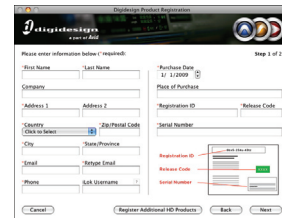


- Click **Next** when done.

### 7. Time to Register

When you first launch Pro Tools, a registration window opens. Be sure to register! It's easy and worth the perks. Among the benefits, you get:

- Limited complimentary technical support
- Future upgrade offers



If you don't register when you first launch, you can register later by double-clicking the Digidesign Registration icon in the Pro Tools folder. It looks like this:



### Third-Party Applications and Plug-ins

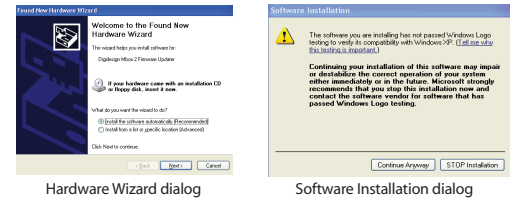
Your Pro Tools package also includes several free applications and plug-ins. Go to the Additional Files > 3rd Party Content folder on your Installer disc. If you purchased a Factory version of the 003 Family system, go to the Additional Files > Factory Bundles Installers folder on your Installer disc.

### 4. Get Installed with Windows (Continued)

- Click **Install**.
- When prompted, connect the FireWire cable to your computer and the other end of the cable to your interface.
- Plug in your power cable, then power up your interface.

- Click **OK**.

[ In Windows XP, a series of Software Installation dialogs about the driver not passing Windows Logo testing may appear. Click **Continue Anyway** on each one until they go away. If any other dialogs appear (such as the "Found New Hardware" dialog), leave them open and do not click on them. These dialogs will close on their own. ]



[ In Windows Vista, a series of Windows Security dialogs may appear. Click **Install** on each one until they go away. ]

- Follow the remaining on-screen instructions.
- When installation is complete, click **Finish** and restart your computer.
- Now you're ready to launch and authorize Pro Tools.

### 8. Record, Compose, Edit, and Make Music

Congratulations! You've just installed your new 003 family interface and Pro Tools LE software. Soon, you'll be making music with a system used by professionals around the world to create hit records.

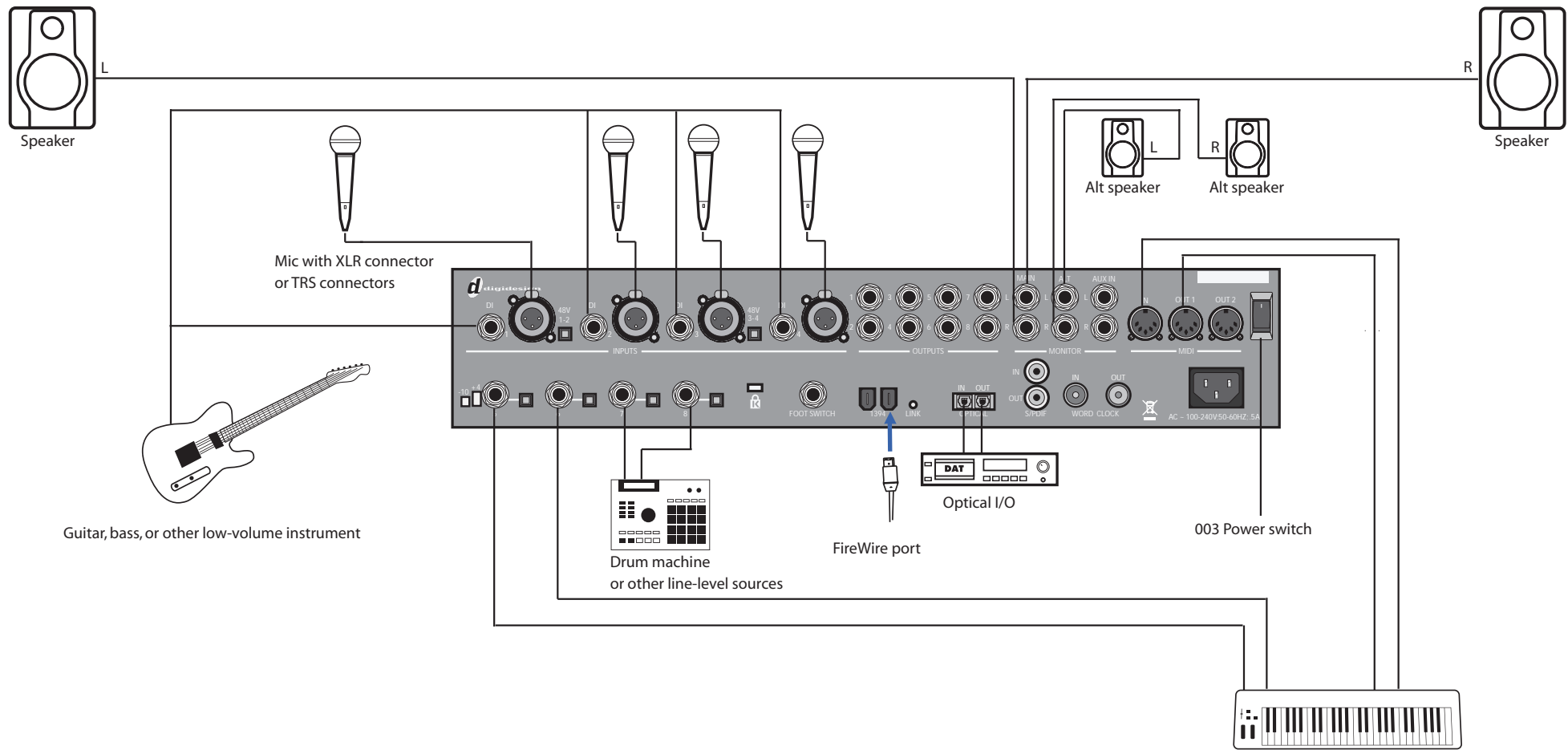

Main Back Panel Connections for the 003 and 003 Rack

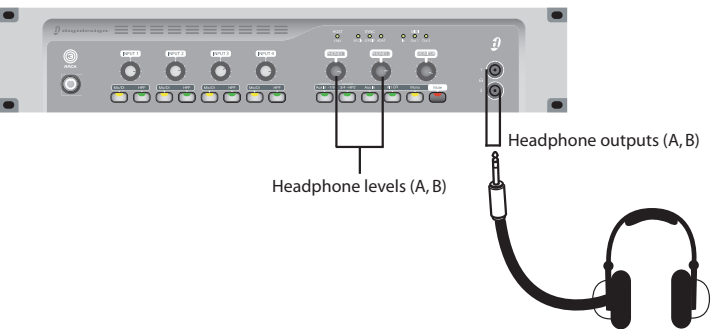


Connecting Headphones on the 003



Tip: In order to hear your Pro Tools session play back, you must have headphones connected. Pro Tools will not play through your computer's sound card.

Back Panel Difference Between the 003 and 003 Rack

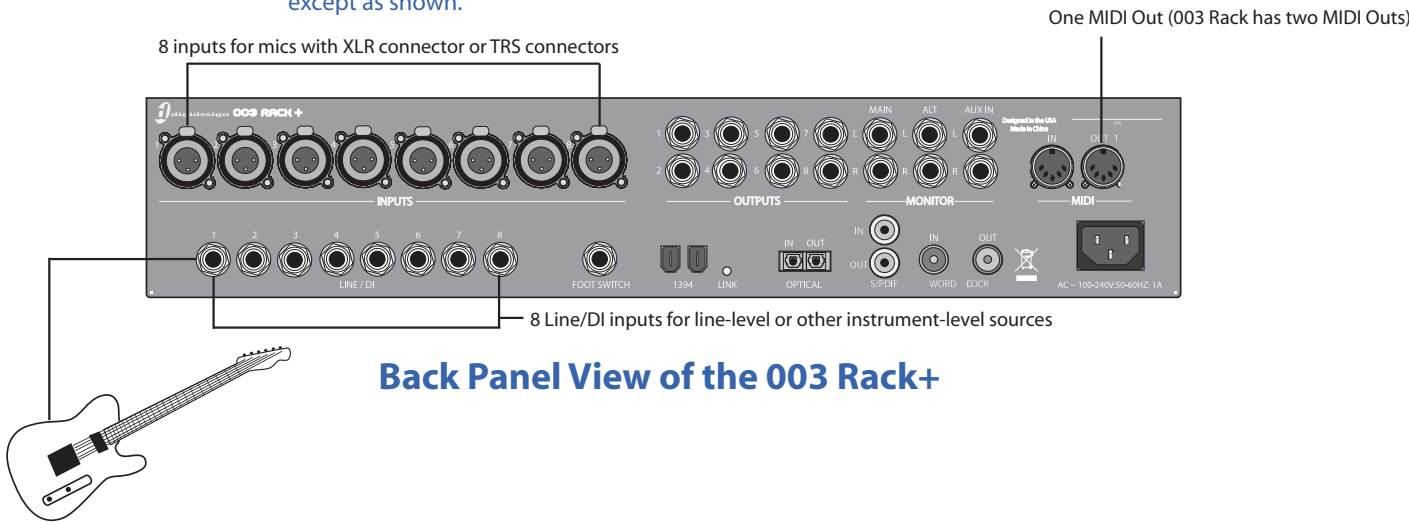
The 003's Power switch is on the back panel, while the 003 Rack's Power switch is on the front panel.



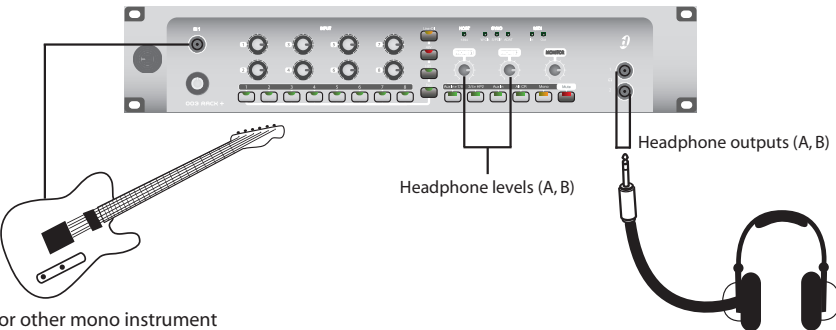
003 Rack, Power switch on front panel

Back Panel Differences Between the 003 Rack and 003 Rack+

The 003 Rack and 003 Rack+ have identical back panel connectors, except as shown.

Tip: There's one front panel input connector, so you can plug in an instrument or mic with a 1/4-inch connector.
